

## The Oregon District's Out on 5th – Noise Restrictions and Guidance - 2021 season

As an entertainer or performer during The Oregon District's Out on 5th 2021 Season you are responsible for keeping noise levels to an absolute minimum by following all City of Dayton Noise Ordinance Guidelines.

Out on 5th will have a specific start and stop time for all approved activity during the event, those times are from 4:00pm to 9:30pm Friday, 12:00pm to 9:30 Saturday, and Sunday.

Guidelines for your performance:

- No amplification except one (1) single source kept at a minimum volume level.
- No bands in public spaces – performers must remain within their provided area.
- No street parties – performers must work to limit large groups from gathering.
- No more than two performers in each location.
- No Roving performances, you must stay within the location you were provided.
- Sound level must be kept at a minimum level at all times.
- All sound generating activity must stop by 9:30pm.
- Please remind spectators not to crowd or block the public right of way.

The Dayton Police Department, the Project Coordinator, or any ODBA member can request a reduction in volume or a halt to noise generating activity at any time. Any guidelines that are not followed may result in the Dayton Police Department, ODBA, or Project Coordinator ending your performance early.
